Transportation

Getting Around in Limassol:

Getting around in Limassol either by car or bus is relatively easy since it is a small city with four main roads running parallel to each other from west to east. The city is well connected through an efficient and cost-effective bus service provided by EMEL Bus Company, PEAL Troodos and Travel Express.

Bus Services

Limassol is centrally located with other cities and towns situated a short distance away. It is recommended to take urban buses that run within the tourist area and town, inter-urban bus services for visiting major towns and rural buses for nearby villages. Buses operate frequently during the day on extended routes and until late evening during the summer (subject to change).

Where to buy tickets: Tickets are issued by the bus drivers when you get on the bus. Weekly, monthly and yearly tickets are available at the main bus stations.

Ticket price (subject to change):

One-way ticket, daytime (04:00 to 21:00): €1.50

One-way ticket, night (21:00 to 04:00): €2.50

You can choose to buy a daily ticket, or a weekly ticket or a monthly ticket, depending on how often you will use the bus. Note however, that the daily or weekly tickets are not valid for night trips (after 21:00). If you want to use the bus after 21:00, you have to buy a one-way night ticket for €2.50, or the monthly ticket that is valid for night trips as well.

Notes:

1. Children under 5 years travel for free
2. Children and Students younger than 18 years travel with 50% discount
3. Owners of Cypriot social card travel for free
4. University students of Cyprus and Foreign Institutions are allowed 50% discount by showing their Student cards

Types of tickets

Daily single: Valid for one trip. Price €1.50

Night single: Valid for one-night trip. Price €2.50

Daily unlimited: Valid for the whole day from the time of issue till 21:00 and offers unlimited trips. Price: €5

Weekly unlimited: Valid for one week and can be used for unlimited trips between 04:00 - 21:00. It is not valid for trips after 21:00. Price: €20

Monthly ticket: Valid for one month for both day and night trips. Price: €40

Car

In order to buy a car in Cyprus you must have a visa. For Non-EU students, you can use your student residence permit and for EU/UK students, you must obtain your yellow slip/residence permit from the migration department here in Cyprus.

Buying or exchanging vehicle ownership

If you are buying a used car and need to exchange vehicle ownership title:

1. Both parts need to complete and sign form TOM 9B:

2. The signed forms must be certified by a certifying officer* (if both people are going to the citizen office together (step 5), you can skip this step)
3. The buyer needs to have evidence of car insurance, valid MOT and the annual road tax**
4. The seller needs to have the logbook/certificate of ownership
5. Go to the Citizens office in Spyrou Araouzou 21, Limassol 3036. Tel: 25 829129

*To get documents certified by a certifying officer, you can contact Ms. Faidra Gregoriou at 25341641 or 99656870, or visit her at 16th June 1943 street, No 24, Limassol City Centre near the main post office and main police station.

** All cars need insurance, a valid MOT and the annual road tax – circulation licence. Please visit the following links for further information:

Driving Licenses

Drivers in Cyprus can drive using a valid EU driving license. Alternatively, drivers holding an international driving license or a national driving license can drive for a period of 30 days to 6 months depending on the country the license was issued and provided it is approved and valid for the class of vehicle they wish to drive from the Cyprus Road Transport Department.
